- Internal electrics, water, and wastewater with quick connection to the plot (models with bathroom).
- Two-year warranty for manufacturing defects according to the EU directive on consumer protection and a further year according to the Swedish Consumer Purchase Act.

- The cost of trailer transport from Sommarnöjen to the customer depends on delivery address and chosen house model. Sommarnöjen's proposals always state trailer transport at a fixed price.
- The cost for lifting the house from the trailer to the construction site by crane (and any reloading required) depends on the site and is calculated by a local contractor at the request of Sommarnöjen.
- The cost of groundworks depends on the construction site and is calculated by a local contractor, at the request of the customer.

Terms of delivery

Agreement

Contracting parties	The customer's contracting party is the Swedish limited liability company Sommarnöjen Scandinavia AB with corporate identity number 556966-3072.
Form of agreement	Upon approval of the quote, a conditional purchase agreement is signed for a pre-assembled house with a fixed price that is guaranteed for six months after the customer makes a first payment of 10 EUR. The customer may cancel the purchase after the payment has been made, until production of the house has started.
Accessibility	When the first payment has been made, Sommarnöjen is responsible for checking that the road to the construction site is passable and that the selected house can be lifted by crane. If the inspection shows that the house cannot be delivered, the customer's total payment equals the first payment, 10 EUR.
Building permit	When accessibility is confirmed, Sommarnöjen will send the customer drawings and documentation of the house to use for building permit application. Sommarnöjen will also hand over drawings (not related to the plot, such as situationplans, landlines etc.) to be used by the local contractor who builds the foundations and makes electricity, water, and sewage connections.

Times

Start of production	Production commences when the customer has decided to go ahead and order the house. This can occur when a building permit has been granted or earlier, if the customer wishes. The date of the start of production is the date when the customer's payment of the initial invoice is made to Sommarnöjen's account (30% of the contracted amount).
Delivery	The house is to be completed and ready for delivery no later than ten months counted from the start of production. No later than ten days after such completion Sommarnöjen will inform the customer about scheduled delivery date.
Manufacturing	Sommarnöjen's homes are hand-crafted indoors under controlled conditions. Windows, kitchens, and interior details are made by carpenters for each individual house. When the house is ready and has passed its inspection, it is transported to the customer completely finished and is lifted onto the site with a mobile crane onto a foundation prepared by the customer.
Changes	Changes to the exterior design, surface layers, options, or locations can be made up until the start of production. After that, no changes can be made.
Moving in	When the house is delivered, the electricity, water, and plumbing must be connected.
Delay	In the event of a delay related to the house, the Swedish Consumer Purchase Act applies. This means that the customer is entitled to compensation for necessary and documented additional costs that have been caused by Sommarnöjen's delay.
Cancellation	After signing the purchase agreement, the customer can cancel the purchase without further costs than the first payment, 10 EUR. After the customer has proceeded, ordered the house, and paid the invoice at the start of production (30%), the customer is responsible for the entire contract amount. Each house is manufactured in accordance with the customer's specification, and the right of withdrawal does not apply.

Safety and security

Self-inspection	Sommarnöjen's self-inspections at the factory are carried out partly by the work teams responsible for the individual steps in the manufacturing process and partly by a general inspector who inspects all parts of the house. The report from the internal inspection is evaluated by the customer's project manager, who approves the house before it leaves the factory.
Liability	According to the EU directive on consumer protection, Sommarnöjen is liable for remedying, free of charge, errors that existed at the time of delivery of the house and that are discovered within a period of two years thereafter. We also apply the Swedish Consumer Purchase Act, which provides an additional one-year warranty.
Insurance	Liability insurance is included.

Drawings

Architecture	Sommarnöjen's houses are created by Sommarnöjen's design team and have been further developed and refined over several generations.
Design	When quote is given for a basic model, principle drawings for floor plans and facades are attached. These drawings form the basis of the quotation. If the quote refers to a house with Individual Design, Individual Adjustment, or other changes, the final design of the house takes place according to a signed agreement and in consultation with Sommarnöjen's architect.
Drawings for building permits	Sommarnöjen provides reasonable and sufficient documentation about the house such as drawings (not related to the plot, such as situation plans, landlines etc.), for the purpose of customer being able to make a building permit application.

Transport

Trailer transport	The cost of trailer transport from Sommarnöjen's factory to the customer depends on where the house is to be delivered and the chosen house model. Sommarnöjen's proposals always state trailer transport as a fixed price.
Crane lift	The cost of lifting the house from the trailer to the construction site by crane (and possibly reloading to a smaller truck if the trailer cannot reach the crane's parking space) depends on the construction site and is added to the actual cost. The cost depends on the construction site and the chosen house model and is calculated by the crane contractor on site. Sommarnöjen assists the customer in finding a suitable crane contractor and providing them with the documentation for their work. The crane contractor will invoice for their work and be responsible directly to the customer.

Groundworks

Liability

Sommarnöjen's fixed price refers to a pre-assembled house above ground. The cost of groundworks (possible ground preparation, foundations, and connection of electricity, water, and wastewater) depends on the construction site and is added to the actual cost.

The customer selects and hires a local contractor for these works and they will invoice for their work and be directly responsible to the customer.

Sommarnöjen provides a basic drawing with dimensions and loads according to which the foundation is to be designed, as well as general recommendations for the foundation. The contractor is responsible for ensuring that the foundation is dimensioned correctly based on Sommarnöjen's documentation, the location of the construction site, ground conditions, and legal requirements. Design and drawings for ground planning are not included.

Other costs

Local costs

The customer's costs for new construction may include, for example, fees for building permits, inspections, and site insurance. The costs vary according to the size of the house and local legislation and are not included in the price.
